5 A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE PROPOSED AD
6 VALOREM TAX MILLAGE RATES FOR THE 2019 TAX
7 YEAR; ADVISING THE PROPERTY APPRAISER OF THE
8 "ROLLED-BACK RATE" AND PROPOSED MILLAGE RATES
9 FOR THE GENERAL SERVICES DISTRICT, EXCEPTING
10 URBAN SERVICES DISTRICTS 2 THROUGH 5 (THE
11 BEACHES AND THE TOWN OF BALDWIN), FOR THE
12 GENERAL SERVICES DISTRICT, INCLUDING ONLY
13 URBAN SERVICES DISTRICTS 2, 3, AND 4 (THE
14 BEACHES); AND FOR THE GENERAL SERVICES
15 DISTRICT, INCLUDING ONLY URBAN SERVICES
16 DISTRICT 5 (THE TOWN OF BALDWIN); SETTING THE
17 DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO
18 CONSIDER THE PROPOSED 2019 MILLAGE RATES AND
19 THE TENTATIVE CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BUDGET
20 FOR THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR; REQUESTING
21 EMERGENCY PASSAGE; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF
22 LEGISLATIVE SERVICES TO DELIVER A COPY OF THIS
23 RESOLUTION TO THE PROPERTY APPRAISER;
24 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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26 **WHEREAS**, the Property Appraiser has certified to the Council
27 the taxable value of real property within the City's taxing
28 jurisdiction, which certification was provided by July 1, 2019; and

29 **WHEREAS**, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires that the
30 Council advise the Property Appraiser of the "rolled-back rate," of
31 the proposed millage rate and of the date of a public hearing on

1 the proposed rates and the tentative budget within thirty-five days
2 of the certification by the Property Appraiser; now, therefore

3 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

4 **Section 1. 2019 Rolled-back Rate Established.** Based upon
5 the certified taxable values provided by the Property Appraiser,
6 the Council has computed and hereby establishes that the "rolled-
7 back rate" of millage under s. 200.065(1), Florida Statutes, is
8 10.8108 mills, or \$10.8108 per \$1,000 assessed taxable value, for
9 the General Services District, excepting Urban Services Districts 2
10 through 5 (the Beaches and the Town of Baldwin); is 7.7216 mills,
11 or \$7.7216 per \$1,000 assessed taxable value, for the General
12 Services District, including only Urban Services Districts 2, 3,
13 and 4 (the Beaches); and is 9.4323 mills, or \$9.4323 per \$1,000
14 assessed taxable value, for the General Services District,
15 including only Urban Services District 5 (the Town of Baldwin).

16 **Section 2. Proposed 2019 Millage Rates.** Based upon the
17 certified taxable values stated in Section 1, and upon
18 consideration of public spirited and competing community interests,
19 the Council proposes to levy millage rates for the 2019 tax year as
20 follows:

21 **2019 PROPOSED MILLAGE RATES**

22 **General Services District, excepting Urban Services Districts 2**
23 **through 5 (the Beaches and the Town of Baldwin)**
24 11.4419 mills (operations), or \$11.4419 per \$1,000 of assessed
25 taxable value;

26 **General Services District, including only Urban Services Districts**
27 **2, 3, and 4 (the Beaches)**
28 8.1512 mills (operations), or \$8.1512 per \$1,000 of assessed
29 taxable value;

30 **General Services District, including only Urban Services District 5**
31 **(the Town of Baldwin):**

1 9.6312 mills (operations), or \$9.6312 per \$1,000 of assessed
2 taxable value;

3 **Section 3. Date, Time and Place for Public Hearing.** The
4 Council will hold a public hearing to consider the proposed 2019
5 millage rates and the tentative Consolidated Government budget on
6 September 10, 2019, at 5:01 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 1st
7 Floor, City Hall, at 117 West Duval Street, Jacksonville, Florida.

8 **Section 4. Requesting Emergency Passage, Pursuant to**
9 **Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** Emergency passage of this resolution
10 is requested. The nature of the emergency is the requirement,
11 pursuant to Section 200.065(2)(b), that the Council advise the
12 Property Appraiser of the "rolled-back rate," of the proposed
13 millage rates and of the date of a public hearing on the proposed
14 rates and tentative budget within thirty-five days of the
15 certification by the Property Appraiser.

16 **Section 5. Delivery to the Property Appraiser.** The Chief
17 of Legislative Services shall, upon approval of this resolution,
18 forthwith deliver a fully executed copy of this resolution to the
19 Duval County Property Appraiser.

20 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become
21 effective upon signature by the Council President.
