**Bill Summary:** This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Taneeisha Hammett as a member of the Sex Trafficking Survivors Leadership Council, for a first full term ending May 31, 2024.

**Background Information:** The Sex Trafficking Survivors Leadership Council is established pursuant to Chapter 96, *Ordinance Code*, and it is an advisory body to the City Council to investigate the root causes of sex trafficking in the City and to develop effective measures to prevent sex trafficking, enhance public awareness of both the problems associated with sex trafficking and to recognize the characteristics of the sex trafficking trade and to advise the Council on potential policies and programs to further the City's goal of eliminating the sex trafficking trade in the City. Section 96.103, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the Survivors Council shall be composed of seven members selected by the Mayor and approved by the City Council.

Ms. Hammett is currently the Account Manager at Dun & Bradstreet. Ms. Hammett has twelve years of customer service and software QA testing with extensive knowledge of QA processes and test methodologies. Ms. Hammett resides in Duval County.
