#### AUDITOR CONCERN

The Emergency Rapid Response Grant is proposed to be paid upon execution of the Redevelopment Agreement and the Developer obtaining all necessary financing required to complete the project. While the agreement includes a clawback provision requiring the Developer repay the Emergency Rapid Response Grant if the project is not completed in accordance with the performance schedule, the City would have to pursue action against the Developer to recover the funds.
