RESOLUTION 2022-296-A

A RESOLUTION HONORING AND CONGRATULATING SAN MARCO BOOKS AND MORE ON 50 YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE JACKSONVILLE COMMUNITY; DECLARING APRIL 30, 2022 AS "INDEPENDENT BOOKSTORE DAY" IN JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 1972, John and Laura Blauer and their son Mike opened the San Marco Bookstore in historic San Marco Square as a used bookstore, which they operated successfully for 27 years; and

WHEREAS, in 1999, Janet and Mike Molyneaux purchased the store, made physical renovations and refined and expanded the bookstore's offerings to better meet the desires of its clientele, adding new books to the inventory and developing outstanding collections of children's books, classic literature, and Jacksonville and Florida history volumes, along with puzzles, games, and other unique literary merchandise; and

WHEREAS, San Marco Books and More is a classic family-owned business now operated by three generations of the Molyneaux family - Janet and Mike, their daughter Desiree Bailey, and her children Colin and Kate. The store is an anchor in San Marco Square, and is deeply committed to supporting other Jacksonville institutions such as the Jacksonville Symphony, the Museum of Science and History, the Jacksonville Public Library, and the San Marco Merchants Association

through literary partnerships and special events; and

WHEREAS, the bookstore is constantly changing with the times to better meet customer needs, including hosting book clubs in the store; facilitating author talks and book signings on a weekly basis; and developing a full-service website that served patron needs during the COVID-19 pandemic and remains a great asset to online visitors; and

WHEREAS, independent bookstores are a vital resource in any community, providing a home for intellectual discourse, the exchange of ideas, debate on issues, the promotion of literacy, and encouraging a love of reading in people of all ages. San Marco Books and More is a shining example among independent bookstores as a fundamental community resource and has faithfully served the needs of the Jacksonville community since 1972; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby honors and congratulates San Marco Books and More on 50 years of outstanding service to its customers and to the citizens of Jacksonville. It extends the City's best wishes for future success to the Molyneaux and Bailey families and thanks them for being cornerstones of the San Marco community and the city at large.

Section 2. The City Council also hereby declares Saturday, April 30, 2022 as "Independent Bookstore Day" in Jacksonville and encourages citizens to patronize independent bookstores on that day and continually in support of the vital role they play in community life.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
