**Bill Summary:** The bill establishes the 2025 special assessments for Florida Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA)-licensed hospitals in Jacksonville to contribute funding to the state's Directed Payment Program (DPP) through the Local Provider Participation Fund (LPPF) at \$29,082 of each hospital's available bed. It sets the public hearings on the assessment for the August 26 and September 9 City Council meetings. The bill adopts a 2025 Assessment Roll and establishes the method of collection as an alternative method pursuant to Chapter 170, Florida Statutes. It authorizes the Mayor to execute the AHCA Letters of Agreement.

**Background Information:** The purpose of this legislation is to renew the annual special assessment for AHCA-licensed hospitals in Jacksonville to fund the non-federal share of the state's Directed Payment Program (DPP) and Low Income Pool (LIP) program through the Local Provider Participation Fund (LPPF). The assessment rate for 2025 is set at \$29,082 per available hospital bed, generating approximately \$104 million in local funding from 12 participating hospitals. This local funding is expected to draw down an estimated \$400–\$450 million in supplemental federal funding.

**Policy Impact Area:** Medicaid health care cost coverage

**Fiscal Impact:** Approximately \$104 million in local funding will be generated for DPP and LIP, drawing an estimated \$400-\$450 million in gross supplemental funding.
