The FDACS grant requires a 40% match; the City of Jacksonville approved \$500,000 for Phase 1 renovations of the Canning Center in FY24. Funds will be used to redevelop Canning Center space to create four kitchenettes/cooking studios, modernize the canning stations, and develop the cottage food classroom, which will provide citizens with six rental and educational opportunities for food preparation, preservation, and cottage food entrepreneurship. Maintenance of the facility should sharply decrease the current need. Staffing is provided by University of Florida/IFAS Extension.
