Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$200,000 from the PSG Micro-Grant Program – Subsidies and Contributions to Private Organizations account to the TSIT Information Technologies – Other General Government Services – Contractual Services account to fund the JaxCode4Change program. The bill provides for the funds to carry over into Fiscal Year 2025–2026.

Background Information: The JaxCode4Change program, currently under development by the Technology Solutions Department, aims to promote workforce development and mentoring opportunities in technology. The program will support the creation of a new dashboard interface and will involve partnerships with private sector and nonprofit organizations to build and expand the program.

Policy Impact Area: Workforce Development; Technology; Public-Private Partnerships

Fiscal Impact: This bill appropriates \$200,000 from the PSG Micro-Grant Program – Subsidies and Contributions to Private Organizations account.
