Request is made to execute the attached lease agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the Fort George Island Volunteer Fire Department for property located at 9363 Heckscher Drive. The initial term of the agreement begins March 31, 2021, and shall end 5 years thereafter, with 2 additional 3-year renewals. This property has been leased for many years and this is a request to renew the lease for the lifeguard station. To build a station at this location would cost significantly more than the lease amount, so continuing to lease would be prudent.

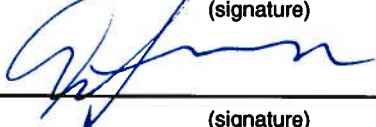
