The subject legislation requests City Council approval of funding commitments associated with a multi-block development effort known as the Pearl Street District improvements, located in the Northcore neighborhood of the Northbank CRA in Downtown Jacksonville.							
The Pearl Street District centers on redevelopment of four blocks and adjacent roadways along Pearl Street beginning at the intersection with Church Street and continuing north to the intersection with Union Street. Three new mixed-use buildings will be developed with residential/retail uses. The fourth building is an existing parking garage that will be rehabilitated to provide additional retail frontage along Beaver Street and will also provide parking for the majority of the residential units. In addition, a new park for public use will be constructed, Porter House Park, along with Pearl Square, both of which are to provide programming such as street fairs, farmers markets, art festivals and pop-up events throughout the year. Each of the four properties provides an ROI ranging from 1.06:1 to 1.17:1.
