**ORDINANCE 2025-426**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$11,760.00 IN GRANT FUNDING RECEIVED FROM THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION (CDC) THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT (FDACS CONTRACT #31825), TO BE USED FOR MOSQUITO CONTROL DIVISION OPERATIONAL EXPENSES AND EQUIPMENT, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-093; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

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(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above comprises an appropriation of \$11,760.00 in funds received from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) through the State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services pursuant to Federal Financial Assistance Subrecipient Agreement (FDACS

Contract #31825) (the "Agreement"), to be used for Mosquito Control Division operational expenses and equipment. The term of the Agreement ends on June 30, 2025. No local match is required.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to utilize funds received from the State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services State Financial Assistance Recipient Agreement for operational and equipment expenses of the Mosquito Control Division including the purchase of supplies and equipment for mosquito control, including bait, traps, batteries and digital microscope and stand. A copy of the Federal Financial Assistance Subrecipient Agreement (FDACS Contract #31825) has been placed **On File** with the Legislative Services Division.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
