Bill Summary: The bill proposes the closure and abandonment of an unopened and unimproved portion of the Orange Street right-of-way, as depicted in Exhibit 1.

Background Information: Ordinance 2022-727-E, which was previously approved by the Council, authorized the redevelopment of the Duval County Armory project site on Market Street at State Street. The Jacksonville Office of Economic Development is requesting that this portion of the right-of-way be closed and abandoned, provided that the City of Jacksonville establish a drainage easement on, over, under, through, and across the area 75 feet west of the closure area. This is deemed a necessary step towards accomplishing the redevelopment.

Policy Impact Area: Right-of-way closure

Fiscal Impact: No direct cost to the City.
