<p style="text-align: right;">94</p> <p>1 Street back in November of last year. Since</p> <p>2 then, the request has been changed to rename</p> <p>3 the street to Frazier Place. So the criteria</p> <p>4 is still the same. It still would honor civil</p> <p>5 rights advocate and Jacksonville native,</p> <p>6 Benjamin "Ben" Frazier. This section would</p> <p>7 only apply -- well, it would apply to the --</p> <p>8 rename the entire portion of Confederate</p> <p>9 Street, between Hubbard Street and North</p> <p>10 Liberty Street.</p> <p>11 Other than that, I mean, based on the best</p> <p>12 of evidence available, we found that the street</p> <p>13 name change would be consistent and compatible</p> <p>14 with the criteria outlined in Chapter 745 of</p> <p>15 the Ordinance Code, and we forward to you a</p> <p>16 recommendation for approval.</p> <p>17 THE CHAIRMAN: Questions for staff?</p> <p>18 COMMISSIONER HOFF: Through the Chair to</p> <p>19 staff, so just to confirm, it is not being</p> <p>20 renamed to Ben Frazier Place --</p> <p>21 MR. WELLS: Yes.</p> <p>22 COMMISSIONER HOFF: -- (inaudible) Frazier</p> <p>23 Place?</p> <p>24 MR. WELLS: Through the Chair to</p> <p>25 Commissioner Hoff, that is correct. And what</p> <p>13 they've done this year is they are having a</p> <p>14 couple of meetings a year out throughout the</p> <p>15 city of Jacksonville. Like, when they approve</p> <p>16 an affordable housing project or get funds for</p> <p>17 an apartment complex and affordable housing or</p> <p>18 whatever they're -- whatever they're doing, and</p> <p>19 they hold a meeting at that place afterwards as</p> <p>20 like a way to be involved with the community</p> <p>21 and what they're doing.</p> <p>22 And that kind of struck me as something</p> <p>23 that we could possibly do, if you guys are</p> <p>24 interested, hold a couple of meetings a year at</p> <p>25 places that we've previously landmarked or</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Diane M.
