Bill Summary: This bill appoints Lawrence R. Swink III to the Building Codes Adjustment Board, replacing Christopher Laymon, for a first full-term expiring September 30, 2026.

Background Information: The Building Codes Adjustment Board is established pursuant to Chapter 56, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to study building codes and recommend to Council needed amendments as may be found necessary or desirable; hear and decide building code enforcement appeals; and authorize building code variances as authorized by law.

Section 56.101(a), *Ordinance Code*, provides that the nine members of the Building Codes Adjustment Board are appointed by the Council.

Mr. Swink attended Terry Parker High School and Jacksonville University. He has more than 25 years of experience in the electrical industry and is the President and CEO of Jackson Lighting & Supply Company. Mr. Swink resides in Duval County in council district 5.
