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## ORDINANCE 2025-404

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$106,000.00 IN FUND BALANCE FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TRUST FUND TO ST. JOHNS RIVERKEEPER, INC. FOR AN ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ASSESSMENT OF THE RIBAULT RIVER AND MONCRIEF CREEK WATERSHEDS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-085; WAIVING SECTION 110.112 (ADVANCE OF CITY FUNDS; PROHIBITION AGAINST), PART 1 (THE CITY TREASURY), CHAPTER 110 (CITY TREASURY), JACKSONVILLE ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A PARTIAL ADVANCE PAYMENT TO ST. JOHNS RIVERKEEPER, INC.; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), JACKSONVILLE ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH ST. JOHNS RIVERKEEPER, INC.; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.108(G) (EXEMPTIONS FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), SUBPART A (GENERAL REGULATIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS; ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), JACKSONVILLE ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH ST. JOHNS RIVERKEEPER, INC.; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of appropriation

The funding above is appropriating fund balance from the Environmental Protection Trust Fund to fund an environmental quality assessment of the Ribault River and Moncrief Creek watersheds (the "Project").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. for the Project, which shall be completed pursuant to the terms, conditions and scope of work more particularly described in that certain Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc., as approved and authorized in Section 6 below.

During its meeting on February 18, 2025, the Jacksonville

Environmental Protection Board approved this expenditure, as reflected in the Monthly Meeting Summary attached hereto as **Exhibit**2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Project will include an environmental quality assessment of the Ribault River and Moncrief Creek watersheds.

Section 3. Waiving Section 110.112, Jacksonville Ordinance Code.

Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1

(The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), Jacksonville

Ordinance Code, is hereby waived to allow for a partial advance

payment to St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. as provided in the Agreement.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Jacksonville Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Jacksonville Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. The City finds that this waiver is justified because St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. has assembled the team to perform the Project and is uniquely positioned to perform the Project in a timely manner.

Section 5. Invoking the exemption pursuant to Section 126.108(g), Jacksonville Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the services of St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. to provide an environmental quality assessment of the Ribault River and Moncrief Creek watersheds. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) (Exemptions from competitive solicitation), Subpart A (General Regulations), Part 1 (General Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Jacksonville Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the

foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Jacksonville Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City an agreement with St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$106,000, subject to the Scope of Services and Budget more particularly described in Exhibit 3, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Jacksonville Ordinance Code.

Section 7. Carryover. The funds appropriated by this
Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 20282029.

Section 8. Oversight Department. The Office of Administrative Services shall oversee the Project.

Section 9. Reports. A report shall be submitted by St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. to the Jacksonville Environmental Protection Board at the conclusion of the Project.

Section 10. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
