KHA is seeking City Council approval to appropriate a \$5,750,000.00 grant received from the U.S. Department of the Treasury for the Social Impact Partnerships to Pay for Results Act (SIPPRA). The grant period will be December 6, 2024-December 31, 2029. This funding will help KHA launch a suite of investments, including a universal nurse home visit for new parents and a universal early literacy initiative through which health care providers coach parents on reading to their children. These investments produce significant governmental savings and value through reductions in newborn ER visits and postpartum maternal depression. This is an outcomes-based federal grant, Department of Treasury will release payments when outcomes are achieved. Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's services to be competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. The waiver is needed to allow KHA to direct contract with Institute for Child Success (project manager) and The Riley institute (independent evaluator).
