To appropriate funding for a grant from the Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Healthier Services Administration (SAMHSA), Center for Substance Abuse Treatment. This is a five year grant with a project t period of 9/30/2023 - 9/29/2028. This will appropriate the funding for year one of the grant, for a budget period of 9/30/2023 - 9/29/2024. Funding will support the costs to expand the substance and use disorder (SUS) treatment and recovery support services in existing drug courts. This award will allow a continuum of care for those in the program, including prevention, harm reduction, treatment, and recovery services, for individuals with SUD involved with the courts. Harm reduction services funded must adhere to federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and other requirements related to such programs or services. Recipients will be expected to screen and assess clients for the presence of SUD and/or co-occurring substance use and mental disorders, screen for infectious diseases for which those with SUDs are at high risk and provide evidence-based and population appropriate harm reduction, treatment, and recovery support services.
