Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, 20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 22 listed in subsection (b): (B.T. 24-121, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein 23 24 by this reference) 25 Appropriated from: (a) \$250,000.00 26 See B.T. 24-121 27 (b) Appropriated to: 2.8 See B.T. 24-121 \$250,000.00 29 (C) Explanation of Appropriation: The funding above is an appropriation of \$250,000.00 from 30 the Mobility Fee - Zone 1 Bike Ped-Activity to the Loretto 31

Road - Sidewalk Project provide funding for the construction of improvements related to the extension of the sidewalk on the south side of Loretto Road from County Dock Road to Mandarin Road (the "Project").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the construction of the Project, including concrete sidewalk and driveways, curb and gutter sections and drainage improvements consisting of drainage structures, pipes, and new ditches on the south side of Loretto Road from County Dock Road to Mandarin Road.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the appropriation of funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay the completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Oversight. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works shall provide oversight for the project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become

effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
