6 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE
7 MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
8 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A FIRST
9 AMENDMENT TO FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 CITY GRANT
10 AGREEMENT FOR THE UNITED WAY 2-1-1 PROGRAM (CITY
11 CONTRACT #701375-26), BETWEEN THE CITY OF
12 JACKSONVILLE AND UNITED WAY OF NORTHEAST
13 FLORIDA, INC., TO AMEND THE PROGRAM BUDGET
14 DETAIL AND NARRATIVE; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUED
15 OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE
16 DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING
17 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **WHEREAS,** the City of Jacksonville ("City") and United Way of
20 Northeast Florida, Inc. ("United Way") previously entered into that
21 certain Fiscal Year 2025-2026 City Grant Agreement for the United Way
22 2-1-1 Program (City Contract #701375-26) dated February 2, 2026 (the
23 "Contract"), as authorized by Ordinance 2025-504-E, to provide
24 funding from the City to United Way in the amount of \$250,000.00 (the
25 "Maximum Indebtedness") to be used to implement the 2-1-1 Program
26 which is a confidential information and referral helpline connected
27 with a crisis and suicide prevention hotline; and

28 **WHEREAS,** United Way has requested to amend the Contract to
29 adjust the program budget details to reallocate funding between
30 certain line items of the budget without increasing the Maximum
31 Indebtedness and apply the revised program budget details to all

1 Services provided on and after October 1, 2025; and

2 **WHEREAS**, United Way has requested the City to enter into a
3 First Amendment to Fiscal Year 2025-2026 City Grant Agreement for the
4 United Way 2-1-1 Program in substantially the form attached hereto
5 as **Exhibit 1**, and incorporated herein by this reference (the "First
6 Amendment"); now therefore

7 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

8 **Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute First**
9 **Amendment to Contract.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or
10 her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to
11 execute and deliver the First Amendment. The First Amendment amends
12 certain line items of the Program Budget Detail and Narrative to
13 reallocate funding to adjust for internal restructuring of United Way
14 staff and roles, program needs and resources allocation, with all
15 other terms and conditions of the Contract remaining unchanged.

16 **Section 2. Oversight.** The Grants and Contract Compliance
17 Division of the Finance Department shall continue to have oversight
18 of the Contract described herein.

19 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
21 without the Mayor's signature.
