## ORDINANCE 2023-54

ΑN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THEMAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE A FOURTH TO THE CONTRACT WITH JACKSONVILLE AMENDMENT UNIVERSITY TO RENEW THE CONTRACT FOR A FOURTH ADDITIONAL YEAR FOR THE CONTINUING MANATEE PROTECTION STUDIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023, SUBJECT TO APPROPRIATION BY CITY COUNCIL; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has engaged Jacksonville University to provide marine science support, particularly in developing and refining the City's Manatee Protection Plan; and

WHEREAS, the University's A. Quinton White, Ph.D., a highly regarded expert on marine mammals, especially manatees, has been the principal scientist under the contract with Jacksonville University; and

WHEREAS, conflict, such as the differing regulatory approaches to manatee protection and the debate over the status of the manatee, indicates the continuing need for marine science support; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the contract with Dr. White through Ordinance 2018-540-E, which invoked Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code, to waive competitive solicitation and bidding due to Dr. White's expertise; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2018-540-E provided for four (4) one-year renewals to the contract; and

WHEREAS, the City has exercised renewal options in Ordinances

2019-645-E, 2020-588-E, and 2021-718-E and now desires to enter into a fourth and final renewal; and

WHEREAS, Jacksonville University has compiled a comprehensive database for the Duval County Manatee Protection Plan over the last 24 years; and

WHEREAS; the City of Jacksonville desires to continue the study of manatees and boaters in the most cost effective manner without interruption; and

WHEREAS, at its January 11, 2023 meeting, the Waterways Commission voted to recommend approval of the proposed contract renewal; and

WHEREAS, the Council would like to exercise the fourth extension to renew the contract for an additional one-year renewal to September 30, 2023; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Authorizing the Mayor and Corporation Secretary to Execute a Fourth Amendment to the Contract for Continuing Manatee Protection Studies, dated October 4, 2018. Subject to appropriation by the City Council, the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are authorized to execute a Fourth Amendment to the contract with Jacksonville University to exercise the fourth one (1) year renewal of the contract term for the services of Dr. A. Quinton White and Dr. Gerard Pinto for continuing manatee protection studies in substantially the same form as contained in the document attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

Section 2. Oversight. The Planning and Development Department shall oversee the Study described herein.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
