AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CHANGE IN THE POLLING PLACE LOCATION FOR PRECINCT 802 TO BE EFFECTIVE FOR THE 2024 PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD AUGUST 20, 2024, IN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS REQUESTED BY THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS PURSUANT TO SECTION 352.102, ORDINANCE CODE; REQUESTING ONE-CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Polling Place Location Change Approved. At the request of the Supervisor of Elections for Duval County, and pursuant to Section 352.102, Ordinance Code, the Council, acting as the governing body for Duval County, hereby approves the polling place location change in precinct 802, as listed in Exhibit 1, attached hereto, to be effective immediately. The Supervisor of Elections and the Council Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to include this polling place location in the Polling Place List on file in their respective offices.

Section 2. Requesting One-Cycle Emergency Passage Upon Introduction Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One-cycle passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is to ensure that affected voters are notified of the polling location change prior to the upcoming August 20, 2024 election.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

without the Mayor's signature.
