4 **ORDINANCE 2025-164**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM THE
6 SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY TO THE GENERAL FUND
7 OPERATING - SALARIES OVERTIME ACCOUNT WITHIN THE
8 JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE ("JSO") TO PROVIDE
9 FUNDING TO JSO FOR OVERTIME SALARIES RELATED TO
10 THE PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICES AT THE
11 SULZBACHER CENTER; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO
12 FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE
13 EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,
17 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
18 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
19 listed in subsection (b):

26 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

27 The funding above is an appropriation of \$100,000 from the
28 Special Council Contingency to the General Fund Operating
29 - Salaries Overtime account within the Jacksonville
30 Sheriff's Office ("JSO") to provide funding to JSO for
31 overtime salaries for the provision of security services

1 at the Sulzbacher Center.

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
3 Section 1 is to provide funds to cover overtime salaries for JSO
4 officers to provide security at the Sulzbacher Center located at 611
5 E. Adams Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32202. The Sulzbacher Center
6 has requested this service because of recent incidents that have
7 occurred outside of their facility raising security concerns for the
8 individuals who are served by the Sulzbacher Center and the employees
9 who work at the center.

10 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated herein shall
11 not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

12 **Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
13 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this
14 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is to allow the
15 security services to commence as soon as possible recognizing the
16 Sulzbacher Center has already experienced employee turnover due to
17 the incidents that have occurred outside the facility.

18 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
20 without the Mayor's signature.
