Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation - The funding above is appropriating \$114,810 from Trail Ridge Landfill Mitigation funds to the Town of Baldwin for purchase of maintenance equipment for Baldwin parks, including 1 chainsaw, 2 backpack blowers, 2 brush cutters, a used cab truck, a backhoe, a 60" zero turn mower and a 6 x 12 mesh sided trailer.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this appropriation is to provide funding to the Town of Baldwin for the purchase of park maintenance equipment to be owned and used by the Town of Baldwin, including 1 chainsaw, 2 backpack blowers, 2 brush cutters, a used cab truck, a backhoe, a 60" zero turn mower and a 6 x 12 mesh sided trailer, which are estimated to cost approximately \$114,810, as identified in Exhibit 2, attached hereto.

Section 3. Oversight/Disbursement of Funds upon Invoice/ Accounting/Reverter. The Mayor is requested to appoint the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department to oversee distribution of funding to the Town of Baldwin. Funds shall be disbursed only after invoices for the listed items have been delivered to the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department. The Town of Baldwin shall provide to the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department a full accounting of all revenues and expenditures for the park maintenance equipment purchased by the Town of Baldwin. Any funds not utilized for the purposes set forth in this ordinance shall be returned to the fund of origin by September 30, 2023. The Department may allocate funding for any of the projects listed in Exhibit 2 in an amount more or less than the projected costs shown in **Exhibit 2** so long as the total costs of the project do not exceed the appropriated amount of \$114,810. The Accounting Division is hereby authorized to transfer funds from one project to another to effectuate this so long as the total costs appropriated herein have not been exceeded.
