ORDINANCE 2023-793

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE CITY-OWNED BUILDING LOCATED AT 6360 COMMERCE STREET, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32211, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 1, PURSUANT TO SECTION 122.105 (PUBLIC BUILDINGS, PUBLIC FACILITIES AND PUBLIC PARKS NAMING AND RENAMING PROCEDURES), ORDINANCE CODE, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "RITA F. REAGAN BUILDING"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Rita F. Reagan was a historical preservationist and urban pioneer who worked tirelessly to preserve the historic fabric of Jacksonville, with a particular focus on the remaining historic structures and properties that played an integral part in Jacksonville's heyday as the "Winter Film Capital of the World"; and

WHEREAS, among her many accomplishments, Rita Reagan is credited with playing an integral part in the campaign to convince the City to purchase the Norman Studios site in Arlington; a goal that was realized when the City purchased the historic complex, minus the set building on Commerce Street, in 2002; and

WHEREAS, for almost two decades Mrs. Reagan was deeply involved in the preservation of Norman Studios, first as part of the Old Arlington, Inc. initiative to save the silent film complex, then as a founding member of Norman Studios Silent Film Museum, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Norman Studios Silent Film Museum, Inc., was created in 2007 with a mission to preserve and restore the entire studio complex, recognizing it as the only surviving race film studio in America, while also conducting educational outreach to honor the

studios' unique place in history; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville recently accomplished its goal to reunify the entire historic Norman Studios complex when it acquired two parcels on the corner of Arlington Road and Shackleton Road, one of which included the original set building; and

WHEREAS, the set building, located at 6360 Commerce Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32211 in Council District 1, is both a Local and National Historic Landmark and is where most of the on-site filming took place; and

WHEREAS, Rita Reagan served for several years as President and Pro Bono Executive Director of the Norman Studios Silent Film Museum and was instrumental in successfully preserving and restoring the studio complex which celebrated the opening of Phase 1 of the Norman Studios Silent Film Museum in the Studios' production building in August after years of renovations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to name the historic set building at Norman Studios the "Rita F. Reagan Building" to honor the significant service and contributions Mrs. Reagan made to the Jacksonville community, and to acknowledge her legacy as the primary preservationist of Norman Studios; and

WHEREAS, this action by the City Council is supported by the Norman Studios Silent Film Museum Board of Directors as reflected in Board Resolution 2023-11-03 dated November 3, 2023, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and the Board of Directors of the Jacksonville Historical Society and Jacksonville History Center as reflected in a letter from Dr. Alan J. Bliss dated October 25, 2023, attached hereto as Exhibit 2; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The building located at 6360 Commerce Street,

Jacksonville, Florida 32211 in Council District 1 is hereby named the

"Rita F. Reagan Building" in accordance with the procedures set forth

in Section 122.105, Ordinance Code. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department, in coordination with Norman Studios Silent Film Museum, Inc., will be responsible for maintenance and upkeep of the entire Norman Studios complex in accordance with the terms of the Partnership Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Norman Studios Silent Film Museum, Inc. dated February 11, 2013.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
