AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 ALLOCATION OF FUNDING PERCENTAGES FOR THE OPIOID SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS FUNDED CATEGORIES, AND ESTABLISHING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 OPIOID SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 84 (OPIOID SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder ("OSUD") Grants Committee met on January 27, 2025, to approve its recommendation for the fiscal year 2025-2026 allocation of funding percentages for the Opioid Settlement Proceeds funded categories; a copy of the minutes of said meeting are attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**; and

WHEREAS, the OSUD Grants Committee met on February 24, 2025, to approve its recommendation for fiscal year 2025-2026 to use the grant application process outlined in Chapter 84 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants), Ordinance Code; a copy of the minutes of said meeting are attached hereto as Exhibit 2; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, having considered the recommendation of the OSUD Grants Committee, hereby establishes the fiscal year 2025-2026 allocation of funding percentages for the Opioid Settlement Proceeds funded categories, and the fiscal year 2025-2026 grant application process; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Allocation of Funding Percentages for Opioid 1 2 Settlement Proceeds Funded Categories Established. Pursuant to 3 Section 84.303 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Funded Categories), Part 4 3 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grant Awards Procedures), Chapter 84 5 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants), Ordinance Code, the following 6 allocation of funding percentages for the Opioid Settlement Proceeds 7 funded categories, as recommended by the OSUD Grants Committee in the 8 letter attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, is hereby established for the 9 fiscal year 2025-2026:

## 2025-2026 Allocation of Funding Percentages for Opioid Settlement Proceeds Funded Categories

- Prevention. The percentage of available funding allocated to this category shall be 34%.
  - Treatment. The percentage of available funding allocated to this category shall be 33%.
    - Recovery Support. The percentage of available funding allocated to this category shall be 33%.

Section 2. Process of Selecting Recipients of Opioid Settlement 18 19 Proceeds Grants Established. Pursuant to Section 84.303 (Opioid 20 Settlement Proceeds Funded Categories), Part 3 (Opioid Settlement 21 Proceeds Grant Awards Procedures), Chapter 84 (Opioid Settlement 22 Proceeds Grants), Ordinance Code, the process of selecting recipients 23 of Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants shall be the grant application process outlined in Chapter 84 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants), 24 Ordinance Code, as recommended by the OSUD Grants Committee in the 25 26 letter attached hereto as Exhibit 3, for the fiscal year 2025-2026.

27 Section 3. Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants to Serve
28 Funded Categories. Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants made by City
29 Council shall be used to exclusively serve the Opioid Settlement
30 Proceeds Grants funded categories. Where a category contains more
31 funding than applied for, the excess funding for that population may

be applied to another category that contains less funding than applied for. Where more than one category has fewer funds than applied for, the excess funding shall be divided among the underfunded categories on a percentage basis where the total amount underfunded in all underfunded categories is the denominator and the amount underfunded in any one category is the numerator.

7 Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 8 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 9 without the Mayor's signature.
