5 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE
6 MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
7 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF
8 THE CITY AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR
9 2025-2026 CITY GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY
10 OF JACKSONVILLE AND I.M. SULZBACHER CENTER FOR
11 THE HOMELESS, INC. FOR THE MENTAL HEALTH
12 OFFENDER PROGRAM AS ORIGINALLY AUTHORIZED BY
13 ORDINANCE 2025-504-E, SUBJECT TO A REVISED
14 BUDGET AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR
15 CONTINUED OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT
16 COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT;
17 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ordinance 2025-504-E, the City Council
20 appropriated \$447,500 to I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless,
21 Inc. ("Sulzbacher") to support the Mental Health Offender Program
22 ("Program"); and

23 **WHEREAS**, Sulzbacher has requested certain adjustments to the
24 budget for the Program; and

25 **WHEREAS**, because this adjustment amounts to more than 10% of
26 the affected line-items, City Council approval of the change is
27 required; now therefore

28 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

29 **Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute.** There is
30 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation
31 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of

1 the City an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 City Grant
2 Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and I.M. Sulzbacher Center
3 for the Homeless, Inc. for the Program, originally authorized by
4 Ordinance 2025-504-E, subject to the Budget Amendment Request Form
5 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this
6 reference, and all other contracts and documents, including
7 extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise
8 take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance,
9 subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General
10 Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management
11 Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements
12 in accordance with Section 128.601, *Ordinance Code*.

13 The revised budget reflects a reallocation of funds from the
14 Compensation Psychiatrist line item to an Operating Expenses
15 Professional Fees line item to better support the Program. There is
16 no change to the overall budget amount. The revised budget shall
17 retroactively apply to October 1, 2025.

18 **Section 2. Oversight.** The Grants and Contract Compliance
19 Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the project described
20 herein.

21 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
23 without the Mayor's signature.
