PURPOSE: White Paper (Explain Why this legislation is necessary? Provide; Who, What, When, Where, How and the Impact.) Council Research will complete this form for Council introduced legislation and the Administration is responsible for all other legislation. (Minimum of 350 words - Maximum of 1 page.) The City of Jacksonville is experiencing significant delays in the collection of curbside residential yard trash. In an effort to alleviate the amounts of yard trash currently set out for collection and to provide efficiencies for our residential collections crews, legislation is presented to enter into a contract and service agreement with Gaston Tree Debris and Recycling LLC for the acceptance of yard trash from the WastePro Hauler Service area (Southeast portion of the City) and for portions of the City Core area collections. Gaston Tree Debris and Recycling LLC currently operates a yard trash processing facility just south of the intersection of JTB and Philips Highway which is well suited for providing a drop off location for yard trash for these service areas. Gaston Tree Debris and Recycling LLC will receive the yard trash, weigh the material, size reduce the material by grinding and deliver the material to Trail Ridge Landfill at a cost of \$42 per ton. The legislation also seeks to allow the Mayor or his designee the ability to enter into additional agreements between the City and contractors/owners/operators as necessary to collect, accept, process, dispose and/or recycle yard trash placed at curbside by City of Jacksonville residents. The legislation provides for a \$1.00 tipping fee for Duval County residents the first 500 pounds of yard trash taken to the City's Trail Ridge Landfill for a period not to exceed 18 months. The legislation also waives portions of Ordinance Code section 380 and 386 as necessary to expedite the ability to transport, process and dispose/recycle residential yard trash with the City of Jacksonville.
