**ORDINANCE 2025-810-E**

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NEW SECTION 106.330  
(DIRECT APPROPRIATIONS; MINIMUM THRESHOLD),  
SUBPART B (SPECIAL PROVISIONS), PART 3  
(APPROPRIATIONS), CHAPTER 106 (BUDGET AND  
ACCOUNTING CODE), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO ESTABLISH  
A MINIMUM THRESHOLD AMOUNT OF \$25,000 FOR CITY  
FUNDING AWARDED TO A FOR-PROFIT OR NOT-FOR-  
PROFIT ORGANIZATION BY DIRECT APPROPRIATION IN  
ACCORDANCE WITH THE EXEMPTION FROM COMPETITIVE  
SOLICITATION OUTLINED IN SUBSECTION 126.108(G),  
*ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION  
INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Creating a New Section 106.330 (Direct  
appropriations; minimum threshold), Subpart B (Special Provisions),  
Part 3 (Appropriations), Chapter 106 (Budget and Accounting Code),  
*Ordinance Code*.** A new Section 106.330 (Direct appropriations; minimum  
threshold), Subpart B (Special Provisions), Part 3 (Appropriations),  
Chapter 106 (Budget and Accounting Code), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby  
created to read as follows:

**CHAPTER 106 - BUDGET AND ACCOUNTING CODE**

**SUBPART B. - SPECIAL PROVISIONS**

Sec. 106.330. - Direct appropriations; minimum threshold.

City funding awarded to a for-profit or not-for-profit organization through a direct appropriation in accordance with the exemption from competitive solicitation outlined in subsection 126.108(g) of this Code shall be in an amount not less than \$25,000.

**Section 2. Codification Instructions.** The Codifier and the Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth herein. Such editorial changes and any other changes necessary to make the *Ordinance Code* consistent with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein, and the changes to the *Ordinance Code* shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
