8 A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUPERVISOR OF  
9 ELECTIONS' DETERMINATION TO PROVIDE TWENTY-FOUR  
10 (24) EARLY VOTING SITES FOR THE 2024  
11 PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY ELECTION, THE  
12 2024 PRIMARY ELECTION, AND THE 2024 GENERAL  
13 ELECTION AND IDENTIFYING THE LOCATIONS, DATES,  
14 AND TIMES FOR EARLY VOTING; PROVIDING AN  
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **WHEREAS**, the Supervisor of Elections is tasked by law with  
18 establishing early voting sites; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Supervisor of Elections Jerry Holland recognizes the  
20 importance of early voting, and the locations, times, and  
21 circumstances under which early voting takes place; and

22 **WHEREAS**, as a result of such importance, Supervisor of  
23 Elections Jerry Holland believes that the community will be better  
24 served if the City Council recommends approval of the early voting  
25 locations and are made more aware of the early voting sites through  
26 the legislative process of City Council approval; and

27 **WHEREAS**, the dates for early voting in 2024 for the  
28 Presidential Preference Primary Election will be March 8, 2024 through  
29 March 16, 2024, and the hours of early voting for the 2024  
30 Presidential Preference Primary Election will be Monday through  
31 Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and

1           **WHEREAS,** the dates for early voting in 2024 for the Primary  
2 Election will be August 5, 2024 through August 18, 2024, and the  
3 hours of early voting for the 2024 Primary Election will be Monday  
4 through Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and

5           **WHEREAS,** the dates for early voting in 2024 for the General  
6 Election will be October 21, 2024 through November 3, 2024, and the  
7 hours of early voting for the 2024 General Election will be Monday  
8 through Sunday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.; and

9           **WHEREAS,** the Supervisor of Elections proposes to conduct early  
10 voting for the Presidential Preference Primary Election, the Primary  
11 Election and the General Election at the locations identified below;  
12 now therefore

13           **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14           **Section 1. Early Voting Sites Approved.** The City Council  
15 hereby expresses its approval of the Supervisor of Elections'  
16 selection of twenty-four (24) early voting locations for the 2024  
17 Presidential Preference Primary Election, the 2024 Primary Election,  
18 and the 2024 General Election as follows:
