
The purpose of the COPS Hiring Program is to advance the practice of community policing through the hire or rehire of additional law enforcement officers. The grant will help cover the costs of hiring 40 new police officers to increase policing capacity to prevent and disrupt crime and violence. The grant provides \$125,000 per position over a 36-month period and requires a cash match of 33.91%.

To appropriate funding for the first year of the COPS Hiring Program (CHP) grant period from 10/1/23 to 09/30/28. This FY24 appropriation includes: \$1,750,000.00 from the US Department of Justice Office of Community Policing Services for hiring 40 police officers, a local grant match and overmatch of \$1,298,436.00 and \$2,178,301.00 in JSO's general fund budget for police equipment and uniforms, and vehicles required for outfitting 40 police officers which are not covered by the grant.
