Bill Summary: This resolution is a request to the Florida Legislature to designate a portion of Interstate 95 as the Warren Alvarez Memorial Bridge. Emergency passage is requested so the resolution can be transmitted to the Florida Legislature for consideration prior to the end of the current legislative session.

Background Information: Former Jacksonville City Council member, the late Warren Alvarez, was a native and lifelong resident of Jacksonville's Northside. Mr. Alvarez served in leadership roles on countless boards, commissions and organizations and was a tenacious advocate for the needs of his constituents. While a council member Mr. Alvarez worked diligently to have I-95 widened as it went over the Trout River Bridge, and as such it is fitting to honor his lifetime of public service by designating that portion of Interstate 95 as the Warren Alvarez Memorial Bridge.
