7 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING JASMINE DARICAUD FOR HER  
8 HEROIC ACTIONS IN ASSISTING VICTIMS OF A TRAFFIC  
9 ACCIDENT AND JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE (JSO)  
10 OFFICER MALIK DARICAUD FOR HIS SUPPORT IN  
11 SECURING EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE; PROVIDING AN  
12 EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 **WHEREAS,** on February 17, 2025, Jasmine Daricaud and her husband  
15 JSO Officer Malik Daricaud, witnessed a severe traffic accident  
16 involving an overturned vehicle; and

17 **WHEREAS,** without hesitation, Jasmine Daricaud sprang into  
18 action, climbing onto the overturned vehicle to assist the driver  
19 inside, demonstrating remarkable bravery and selflessness in a  
20 dangerous situation; and

21 **WHEREAS,** while off-duty Officer Malik Daricaud promptly and  
22 calmly contacted emergency responders to ensure immediate assistance,  
23 Jasmine Daricaud remained on top of the vehicle trying to extract the  
24 driver out of the vehicle until first responders arrived; and

25 **WHEREAS,** Officer Malik Daricaud, who was previously wounded in  
26 the line of duty, continues to demonstrate resilience and dedication  
27 to serving his community, further demonstrating his commitment to  
28 public safety; and

29 **WHEREAS,** Jasmine Daricaud's fearless response exemplifies  
30 extraordinary courage and an unwavering commitment to helping others  
31 in times of crisis, embodying the highest ideal of community service

1 and personal heroism; and

2       **WHEREAS,** the Daricauds' combined efforts reflect the spirit of  
3 service, with Officer Daricaud ensuring critical emergency  
4 coordination and Jasmine Daricaud putting herself at risk to aid  
5 those in need; now therefore

6       **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

7       **Section 1.** The City Council hereby commends both Jasmine  
8 Daricaud for her outstanding bravery and decisive action in assisting  
9 victims of a traffic accident and JSO Officer Malik Daricaud for his  
10 role in securing emergency assistance. Their actions serve as an  
11 inspiration to the Jacksonville community.

12       **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become  
13 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
14 without the Mayor's signature.
