Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Keith Doles as a member of the Art in Public Places Committee, replacing Tracie Thornton, as an art professional, for a first full term ending December 31, 2022.

Background Information: The Art in Public Places Committee is established pursuant to Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, and charged to choose art which is compatible with and which will enhance the architecture and general environment of the City; receive, review and act on the recommendations of the Art Selection Panels; seek to ensure that at least 15% of the artists selected for purchase or commission will be resident(s) in the Greater Jacksonville area (Duval, St. Johns, Nassau, Clay and Baker Counties); and also encourage the selection of regional artists e.g. Florida and the Southeastern United States.

Section 126.903, Ordinance Code, provides that the eleven members of the committee are appointed by the Mayor, with three of the members from the professions of architecture, interior design, landscape architecture, planning, art professional, or art historian.

Mr. Doles is presently a Studio Artist at CoRK Arts District and previously was a Fine Arts Instructor, Division of Continuing Education at the University of North Florida from 2015 to 2020. Mr. Doles has a master's degree in Business from Webster University. Mr. Doles resides in Duval County.
