4 **ORDINANCE 2023-557-E**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$227,218.83 FROM  
6 LOCAL OPTION GAS TAX-FUND/SIDEWALK  
7 CONSTRUCTION-NEW TO FUND THE DESIGN AND  
8 ADMINISTRATION PORTION OF THE STARRATT ROAD  
9 SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, AS INITIATED BY  
10 B.T. 23-117; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; AMENDING  
11 THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT  
12 PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-E TO  
13 REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS; PROVIDING  
14 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
18 within the City’s budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
20 listed in subsection (b):

27 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:  
28 The funding above is a transfer of funds from Local Option  
29 Gas Tax - Fund/Sidewalk Construction-New to provide funding  
30 for the design and administration portion of the Starratt  
31 Road Sidewalk Improvements project (the “Project”).

1           **Section 2.           Purpose.**    The purpose of the appropriation in  
2 Section 1 is to provide funding for the design and administration  
3 portion of the Project. These funds will cover related costs to final  
4 design engineering plans and specifications for the left extension  
5 of the box culvert carrying Starratt Road over Dunn Creek, addition  
6 of a new sidewalk on the north side, necessary reconfiguration of the  
7 existing sidewalk on the south side and necessary connections to the  
8 existing sidewalk on north and south side.

9           **Section 3.           CIP Amendment.**   Ordinance 2022-505-E, being the  
10 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and  
11 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide  
12 funding for the Project. The project is more fully described in the  
13 Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, and  
14 incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the  
15 deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget  
16 and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the  
17 community because such deferral will result in unnecessary delay in  
18 the construction of sidewalk infrastructure.

19           Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of  
20 this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
21 Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment  
22 set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an  
23 amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-  
24 Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E  
25 shall continue in full force and effect.

26           **Section 4.           Effective Date.**   This Ordinance shall become  
27 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
28 without the Mayor's signature.
