6 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING JASMINE DARICAUD FOR HER
7 HEROIC ACTIONS IN ASSISTING VICTIMS OF A TRAFFIC
8 ACCIDENT AND JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE (JSO)
9 OFFICER MALIK DARICAUD FOR HIS SUPPORT IN
10 SECURING EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE; PROVIDING AN
11 EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 **WHEREAS,** on February 17, 2025, Jasmine Daricaud and her husband
14 JSO Officer Malik Daricaud, witnessed a severe traffic accident
15 involving an overturned vehicle; and

16 **WHEREAS,** without hesitation, Jasmine Daricaud sprang into
17 action, climbing onto the overturned vehicle to assist the driver
18 inside, demonstrating remarkable bravery and selflessness in a
19 dangerous situation; and

20 **WHEREAS,** while off-duty Officer Malik Daricaud promptly and
21 calmly contacted emergency responders to ensure immediate assistance,
22 Jasmine Daricaud remained on top of the vehicle trying to extract the
23 driver out of the vehicle until first responders arrived; and

24 **WHEREAS,** Officer Malik Daricaud, who was previously wounded in
25 the line of duty, continues to demonstrate resilience and dedication
26 to serving his community, further demonstrating his commitment to
27 public safety; and

28 **WHEREAS,** Jasmine Daricaud's fearless response exemplifies
29 extraordinary courage and an unwavering commitment to helping others
30 in times of crisis, embodying the highest ideal of community service
31 and personal heroism; and

1 **WHEREAS,** the Daricauds' combined efforts reflect the spirit of
2 service, with Officer Daricaud ensuring critical emergency
3 coordination and Jasmine Daricaud putting herself at risk to aid
4 those in need; now therefore

5 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

6 **Section 1.** The City Council hereby commends both Jasmine
7 Daricaud for her outstanding bravery and decisive action in assisting
8 victims of a traffic accident and JSO Officer Malik Daricaud for his
9 role in securing emergency assistance. Their actions serve as an
10 inspiration to the Jacksonville community.

11 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
13 without the Mayor's signature.
