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## ORDINANCE 2024-838-W

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM A SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY TO THE PRE-TRIAL OPERATIONS ACTIVITY - CONTRACTUAL SERVICES ACCOUNT WITHIN THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE, TO PROCURE THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES OF CGL MANAGEMENT SERVICES, LLC, TO CONDUCT A POPULATION STUDY OF THE DUVAL COUNTY JAIL (THE "STUDY") AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; INVOKING EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.108(G) (EXEMPTIONS FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS; ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH CGL MANAGEMENT SERVICES, LLC; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND CGL MANAGEMENT SERVICES, LLC, FOR PROVISION OF SERVICES TO COMPLETE THE STUDY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$100,000 from a Special Council Contingency to the Pre-Trial Operations Activity - Contractual Services account within the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office, to procure the professional services of CGL Management Services, LLC, to conduct a population study of the Duval County jail (the "Study") as described herein.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds to procure the professional services of CGL Management Services, LLC (the "Contractor"), to conduct a study to produce a complete profile and analysis of the Duval County jail population, a ten-year jail population forecast, and a review and recommendation for the jail classification system. The specific research, tasks, and deliverables required of the Contractor for completion of the Study are outlined in the Proposal attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure the professional services of CGL Management Services, LLC, for the Study. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) (Exemptions from competitive solicitation), Part 1 (General Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those

specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

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Section 4. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City a grant agreement with CGL Management Services, LLC, in an amount not-to-exceed \$100,000, to complete the Study described in Exhibit 2 for a term commencing on January 1, 2025 through September 30, 2025. The agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or her designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the agreement by the Mayor, or her designee; provided however, no modification to the agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of CGL Management Services, LLC, as stated in the agreement, and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel and the Office of Risk Management for appropriate insurance and indemnification terms. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the agreement.

Section 5. Oversight Department. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
