**Bill Summary:** This bill reappoints Mark VanLoh to the Duval County Tourist Development Council (TDC), as a commercial airline industry/Jacksonville Aviation Authority representative, for a second full term expiring June 30, 2028.

**Background Information:** The TDC is established pursuant to Chapter 70, *Ordinance Code*, and Section 125.0104, *Florida Statutes*, and charged to recommend a method of coordination of existing tourist development efforts by both public and private agencies, organizations and business and of new or additional tourist development efforts; identify and recommend methods of eliminating unnecessary duplications in existing tourist development efforts; identify and develop new tourist development efforts; create, prepare and submit to the Council a tourist development plan; and review the expenditures of revenues from the Tourist Development Trust Fund and report any unauthorized expenditures to the Council and State Department of Revenue.

Section 70.102(a)(5), *Ordinance Code*, provides that one of the nine members shall have experience and background in the commercial airline industry or the Jacksonville Aviation Authority.

Mr. VanLoh hods a bachelor's degree in aviation/business management from Minnesota State University. He is the CEO of the Jacksonville Aviation Authority, and previously managed airports in Tulsa, Kansas City, Chattanooga and Cleveland. Mr. VanLoh resides in Duval County in council district 11.
