9 FUNDS FROM SPECIAL EVENTS - FLORIDA GEORGIA
10 GAME CONTINGENCY TO GENERAL FUND/ GENERAL
11 SERVICES DISTRICT EQUAL BUSINESS OPPORTUNITY
12 OFFICE TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR AN UPDATED
13 MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL DISPARITY STUDY;
14 PROVIDING FOR PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER
15 OF FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE
16 PROCUREMENT DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE

19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
22 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
23 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

30 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation**

1 The funds above are being appropriated from Special
2 Events - Florida Georgia Game Contingency funds for the
3 costs associated with updating the Jacksonville Multi-
4 Jurisdictional Disparity Study as originally prepared by
5 Mason Tillman Associated, Ltd.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
7 Section 1 is to provide funding for an updated comprehensive
8 disparity study. The original disparity study was performed by
9 Mason Tillman Associates, Ltd, in 2013. The JSEB Special Committee
10 has made recommendations in Ordinance 2021-117, currently pending,
11 to update the 2013 study.

12 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in this
13 ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2022-
14 2023.

15 **Section 4. Oversight Department.** The Procurement Division
16 of the Finance and Administration Department shall select a
17 consultant to provide the updated disparity study pursuant to the
18 provisions of Chapter, 126, *Ordinance Code*, and shall oversee the
19 completion of the updated study.

20 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
22 without the Mayor's signature.
