ORDINANCE 2024-421-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,000,000 FROM THE MANAGEMENT FUND TO AN EXISTING PROJECT ENTITLED "HANS G. TANZLER, JR. MARINA" ("PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY REVISED 24-107; AMENDING THE 2024-2028 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2023-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, Section 1. within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b): (Revised B.T. 24-107, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 1, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev B.T. 24-107, June 17, 2024 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference):

(C) Explanation of Appropriation:

> The funding above reduces debt management fund debt service repayment within the general fund to increase

pay-go funding and reduce borrowing in the Hans G. Tanzler, Jr. Marina project (the "Project").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2 is to provide additional pay-go funding for the Project and reduce debt funding authorization.

Section 3. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide funding for the Project more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP Sheet, June 17, 2024 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Oversight Department. The Department of Public Works shall oversee the Project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
