5 A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING THE
6 TRINITY CHRISTIAN ACADEMY'S GIRLS' SOFTBALL
7 TEAM ON WINNING THE FLORIDA CLASS 4A STATE
8 CHAMPIONSHIP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 **WHEREAS**, the Trinity Christian Conquerors girls softball team
11 finished their regular season with a 15-6 record, winning the
12 District 2 championship and the right to host the opening rounds of
13 the playoffs; and

14 **WHEREAS**, a 10-0 shutout of Florida High of Tallahassee and a
15 5-1 victory over district rival Providence earned the Conquerors a
16 trip to the state semifinals, where they defeated Oxbridge Academy
17 on the road in West Palm Beach by a score of 10-3 to send them to
18 the Class 4A championship game against powerhouse Westminster
19 Christian of Miami, the 2-time defending state champions and
20 winners of the state title in four of the last five years; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Conquerors, appearing in a rematch of the 2018
22 championship game won by the Westminster Warriors by a 6-1 score,
23 produced a win for the ages in their seventh trip to the final four
24 and fifth championship game with a resounding 16-0 victory in Vero
25 Beach in a 4-inning game halted by the "mercy rule", a score that
26 tied the record for the largest margin of victory in a Florida
27 softball title game; and

28 **WHEREAS**, led by Florida Dairy Farmers Class 4A Coach of the
29 Year JR Borden and Amaya Ross, who finished third in the balloting
30 for Class 4A Player of the Year, the Trinity Christian girls
31 finally achieved the school's first ever softball state

1 championship and brought tremendous excitement and pride to the
2 Jacksonville community; now therefore

3 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

4 **Section 1.** The City of Jacksonville hereby honors and
5 commends the Trinity Christian Academy Conquerors girls' softball
6 team on their outstanding season and the school's first softball
7 state championship. The City Council extends to Head Coach JR
8 Borden and his assistant coaches, the players, and the faculty,
9 staff, students and supporters of Trinity Christian Academy its
10 congratulations on this great accomplishment and its very best
11 wishes for more academic and athletic successes in the years to
12 come.

13 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
14 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
15 without the Mayor's signature.
