Bill Summary: This bill amends Section 602.408 (Lobbying, Employment or Consulting by former appointed officials required to file Form 1 Financial Disclosures; Prohibition), Subpart A (Conflicting Relationships), Part 4 (Conflicts of Interest), Chapter 602 (Jacksonville Ethics Code), *Ordinance Code*. One cycle emergency passage is requested to provide as much advance notice to affected appointed employees as possible.

Background Information: Per Ordinance 2020-160-E, Council approved revisions to the City's Ethics Code to prohibit lobbying, employment or consulting for compensation by former appointed officials required to file Form 1 Financial Disclosures to the board, commission, committee, council or authority of which the person was an appointed official for a period of 2 years after vacating that position. The purpose of this legislation is to extend this prohibition to include certain appointed employees of the City of Jacksonville, specifically appointed employees of the Mayor's Office, except persons employed solely in maintenance, clerical, secretarial or similar positions.

Policy Impact Area: Ethics Code - lobbying, employment or consulting by former appointed officials
