AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM A DESIGNATED CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS AND AIDS ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO SUITED FOR SUCCESS JACKSONVILLE, INC., FOR THE OPERATION SUCCESS PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") DESCRIBED HEREIN; INVOKING EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH SUITED FOR SUCCESS JACKSONVILLE, INC.; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH SUITED FOR SUCCESS JACKSONVILLE, INC.; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND SUITED FOR SUCCESS JACKSONVILLE, INC. FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACTS COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$10,000 from a Designated Contingency account to the Miscellaneous Grants and Aids account to provide funding to Suited for Success Jacksonville, Inc. ("Suited for Success") for operating costs for the Operation Success Program (the "Program"). This pilot program provides career development and on-the-job training opportunities for men and women re-entering the workforce.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to Suited for Success for the Program as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program is designed to provide coaching, mentoring and training to ex-offenders seeking employment and/or re-entry into the workforce. The City funds appropriated herein will allow Suited for Success to assist 50 individuals seeking to obtain life-skills training and to increase their employability. Participants in the Program will also receive clothing suitable to wear during interviews when seeking employment.

Section 3. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g),

Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure

the professional services of Suited for Success Jacksonville, Inc. to administer the Program described herein. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with Suited for Success Jacksonville, Inc. This waiver is justified because Suited for Success has been providing career development, employability and job readiness services for over 20 years. The City funds appropriated herein will allow Suited for Success to expand its programming to reach additional at-risk men and women who are transitioning from social services programs in Duval County. This Program, combined with other wraparound services provided by Suited for Success, as well as it's connections within the Jacksonville community mean this non-profit is well positioned to have a significant impact on the City's ex-offender population and their families.

Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City an agreement with Suited for Success Jacksonville, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$10,000, subject to the Scope of Services and Budget more particularly described in Exhibit 2, for a term commencing on October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, and all other contracts
