5 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE
6 MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
7 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AMENDMENT TO
8 THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 CITY GRANT AGREEMENT
9 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND GOODWILL
10 INDUSTRIES OF NORTH FLORIDA, INC. (THE
11 "AGREEMENT"), ORIGINALLY APPROVED AND
12 AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE 2024-466-E, TO EXTEND
13 THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT TO EXPIRE ON SEPTEMBER
14 30, 2026, TO EXTEND CERTAIN OTHER RELATED DATES
15 AND DEADLINES WITHIN THE AGREEMENT, AND TO
16 REVISE THE BUDGET AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING
17 FOR CONTINUED OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND
18 CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE
19 DEPARTMENT; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY
20 PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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22 **WHEREAS,** Ordinance 2024-466-E appropriated \$785,000 and
23 authorized the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary,
24 to execute, on behalf of the City, a grant agreement between the City
25 and Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc. ("Goodwill"), for the
26 Building Futures Together - A Goodwill Workforce Training Program
27 (the "Program") for a term ending on September 30, 2025; and

28 **WHEREAS,** Goodwill has requested an extension to the term of
29 the grant agreement through September 30, 2026, due to the unexpected
30 delays in the buildout of their facility and initiating the Program,
31 and has further requested certain adjustments to the approved Program

1 budget as further described herein; now therefore

2 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

3 **Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute Amendment**
4 **to Agreement.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her
5 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to
6 execute and deliver, an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 City
7 Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Goodwill
8 Industries of North Florida, Inc. (the "Agreement"), originally
9 approved and authorized by Ordinance 2024-466-E, to extend the term
10 of the Agreement to September 30, 2026, to extend certain related
11 dates and deadlines based on the extension to the term authorized
12 herein, and to replace the Program Budget approved by Ordinance 2024-
13 466-E with the revised Program Budget attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**
14 and incorporated herein by this reference, with all other terms and
15 conditions of the Agreement remaining unchanged. The changes to the
16 Program budget are summarized in more detail on **Exhibit 2** attached
17 hereto.

18 **Section 2. Oversight.** The Grants and Contract Compliance
19 Division of the Finance Department shall continue to have oversight
20 of the Agreement described herein.

21 **Section 3. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
22 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this
23 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the
24 Agreement is currently set to expire on September 30, 2025, and the
25 Council and Goodwill want to ensure there is not a lapse in the
26 contract term.

27 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
29 without the Mayor's signature.
