## ORDINANCE 2023-767-E

AND APPROPRIATING \$3,979,060 FROM THE MARINE FIRE STATION #68 PROJECT AND \$2,000,000 FROM THE FIRE STATION #48 - NEW CONSTRUCTION PROJECT PROVIDE A CONTRIBUTION OF \$5,979,060 TO THE JACKSONVILLE PORT AUTHORITY ("JAXPORT") PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDING FOR A FEDERAL GRANT RECEIVED BY JAXPORT TO DESIGN, ENGINEER, AND CONSTRUCT A NEW FIRE STATION #48 AT BLOUNT ISLAND, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-015; AMENDING THE 2024-2028 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2023-505-E TO REFLECT THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS AUTHORIZED HEREIN; AMENDING ORDINANCE 2023-504-E, THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TO REPLACE REVISED SCHEDULE B4, THE FY 23-24 DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND DETAIL, AND REVISED SCHEDULE B4-B, THE FY 23-24 IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS CAPITAL FUNDED BORROWING, TO REFLECT THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS AUTHORIZED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025; AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO A FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH JAXPORT AS FURTHER DETAILED THEREIN ("FUNDING AGREEMENT"); AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO

A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH JAXPORT FOR THE NEW FIRE STATION #48 FOR AN INITIAL TERM OF 30 YEARS AT A RATE OF \$1 PER YEAR ("LEASE AGREEMENT"); PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT AS TO THE FUNDING AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT ("JFRD") AS TO THE LEASE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, originally built in 1978, Fire Station #48 at Blount Island can no longer safely accommodate the number of firefighters needed to staff the assigned fire and rescue apparatus based there; and

WHEREAS, in addition, there is inadequate bay space for the foam tanker at Fire Station #48, and it is subject to flooding, and lacks provision for female firefighters; and

WHEREAS, JAXPORT has secured \$5,979,060 in federal grant funding from the Department of Defense for the construction of a new Fire Station #48 (the "Project") to serve the port, military and surrounding residential community near Blount Island due to the port's unique classification as a "Port of Strategic Significance"; and

WHEREAS, JAXPORT has requested and the City has agreed to provide \$5,979,060 in funding as a local match for the Project which JAXPORT will design, engineer, and construct; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Findings. It is hereby ascertained, determined, found, and declared as follows:

- (a) The recitals set forth herein are true and correct.
- (b) The Project will promote and further the public and municipal purposes of the City.

(c) The provision of the City's assistance as identified in the Funding Agreement is necessary and appropriate to make the Project feasible; and the City's assistance is reasonable and not excessive, taking into account the extent of the public benefits expected to be derived from the Project, and taking into account all other forms of assistance available.

- (d) JAXPORT and its contractors, on behalf of JAXPORT, are qualified to carry out and complete the construction and equipping of the Project.
- (e) The authorizations provided by this Ordinance are for public uses and purposes for which the City may use its powers as a county, municipality and as a political subdivision of the State of Florida and may expend public funds, and the necessity in the public interest for the provisions herein enacted is hereby declared as a matter of legislative determination.

Section 2. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated and transferred, as applicable, the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b): (B.T. 24-015 is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference)

(c) Explanation of Appropriation and Transfer:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$3,979,060 from the CIP Project entitled "Marine Fire Station #68" and \$2,000,000 from the CIP Project entitled "Fire Station #48 - New Construction" to provide a contribution of \$5,979,060 to JAXPORT to provide matching funding for a

federal grant awarded to JAXPORT to construct the Project.

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to timely provide matching funding of \$5,979,060 to JAXPORT so JAXPORT can proceed with design, engineering and construction of the Project which, when completed, will be leased to JFRD for \$1 a year for an initial term of 30 years.

Section 4. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the reduction of funding within the Marine Fire Station #68 and Fire Station #48 - New Construction projects as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP Sheets November 20, 2023 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in unnecessary delay of the Project and loss of grant funding for the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the CIP approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Amending 2023-504-E, the FY 2023-2024 Budget Ordinance, to replace Revised Schedule B4 and Revised Schedule B4-b to provide funding to JAXPORT for the Project. 2023-504-E, the FY 2023-2024 Budget Ordinance, is hereby amended to replace Revised Schedule B4, entitled "FY 23-24 Debt Management Fund Detail", and

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Capital Improvement Projects. The Second Revised Schedule B4 and Second Revised Schedule B4-b are attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 4, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 4, 2nd Rev Scheds B4 & B4-b, November 20, 2023 - NCSPHS". Section 6. Carryover. The funds appropriated by this

Revised Schedule B4-b, entitled "FY 23-24 Capital Improvement

Projects Funded via Borrowing", to reflect the contribution of

\$5,979,060 to JAXPORT for the Project and reduce the borrowing for

Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-2025.

Section 7. Authorizing the Mayor to enter into a Funding Agreement and Lease Agreement with the Jacksonville Port Authority. The Mayor, or her designee, is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into a Funding Agreement and Lease Agreement with JAXPORT substantially in accordance with the term sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 3 for the purposes of funding the Project.

Section 8. Oversight Department. The Finance and Administration Department shall provide oversight for the Funding Agreement authorized herein. JFRD shall provide oversight for the Lease Agreement authorized herein.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become Section 9. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
