ORDINANCE 2025-655-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$2,474,030.29 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING FUND - INTERFUND TRANSFER IN ACCOUNT, REPRESENTING RETURNED FUNDING RELATED TO TERMINATION OF THE JACKSONVILLE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 2023-496-E, TO THE STARRATT ROAD AND YELLOW BLUFF ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT - OTHER CONSTRUCTION COSTS ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF STARRATT ROAD AND YELLOW BLUFF ROAD; AMENDING THE 2025-2029 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2024-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE NEW PROJECT ENTITLED "STARRATT ROAD AND YELLOW BLUFF ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT"; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$2,474,030.29 from the General Fund Operating Fund - Interfund Transfer In account, representing returned funding related to termination of the Jacksonville International Airport Community Redevelopment Agency pursuant to Ordinance 2023-496-E, to the Starratt Road and Yellow Bluff Road Intersection Improvement - Other Construction Costs account, to provide funds for construction of improvements at the intersection of Starratt Road and Yellow Bluff Road.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds for construction of improvements at the intersection of Starratt Road and Yellow Bluff Road. The improvements are intended to serve as a temporary solution to address traffic concerns at this intersection until a future intersection reconstruction project can be completed.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2024-505-E, adopting the 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the new project entitled "Starratt Road and Yellow Bluff Road Intersection Improvement" (the "Project"), as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay commencement of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this Section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2024-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2024-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Oversight. The Public Works Department shall have oversight of the Project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
