Bill Summary: This bill approves and authorizes the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary to execute and deliver an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 City Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc., originally approved by Ordinance 2024-466-E. The amendment extends the term of the agreement to expire on September 30, 2026, extends related dates and deadlines, and revises the program budget. Oversight will continue to be provided by the Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department. The legislation requests one cycle emergency passage.

Background Information: Ordinance 2024-466-E appropriated \$785,000 and authorized a grant agreement with Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc. to support the Building Futures Together- A Goodwill Workforce Training Program, with a contract term ending September 30, 2025. Due to delays in the facility buildout and program initiation, Goodwill has requested an extension of the contract term through September 30, 2026, to allow for full implementation of the program. The bill also revises the program budget, replacing the budget previously approved in Ordinance 2024-466-E with the revised program budget. All other terms and conditions of the original agreement remain unchanged.
