Office of Economic Development (OED) is proposing to submit legislation authorizing the City to amend an existing redevelopment agreement with White Harvest Farms, LLC which was adopted by Ordinance 2018-509-E. The amendment simply removes the requirement within the agreement that White Harvest Farms build a pedestrian bridge. The scope as originally presented to the OED included the construction of a pedestrian bridge. Through the review of the project by staff, it was noted that the bridge was not included in the cost estimates. Staff contacted White Harvest Farms and was informed that the complications were expected with permitting in environmentally sensitive soils and this would generally increase the budget beyond expectations.

The City's investment in the Project remains a maximum of \$1.5 million in reimbursable grant funding from the Northwest Economic Development Fund. No additional modifications to the agreement are being requested.
