9 RESOLUTION 2004-277-A, AS AMENDED IN RESOLUTIONS  
10 2005-710-A, 2006-1018-A, 2009-904-A, 2010-907-  
11 A, 2012-465-A AND 2017-709-A, AND REQUIRED BY  
12 CHAPTER 252, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND CHAPTER 674,  
13 *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY  
14 THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT;  
15 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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17 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. City of Jacksonville Comprehensive Emergency**  
19 **Management Plan revisions approved.** Pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida  
20 Statutes, and Chapter 674, *Ordinance Code*, the City of  
21 Jacksonville/Duval County has developed and maintains a county  
22 emergency management plan and program that is coordinated with the  
23 State of Florida's emergency management plan and program. Local  
24 emergency management plans are designed to provide guidance and  
25 procedures relative to emergency preparedness and management and act  
26 as a mechanism that allows for standardization of policies and  
27 procedures to facilitate an integrated and coordinated response among  
28 local, state, and federal government and non-profit entities to  
29 protect against, prepare for, respond to, recover from, and mitigate  
30 the impacts of a wide variety of disasters.

31 To ensure compliance with various State requirements and the

1 National Incident Management System, the City has incorporated  
2 certain revisions and updates to its 2021 Comprehensive Emergency  
3 Management Plan (CEMP), a copy of which has been placed **On File** with  
4 the Office of Legislative Services, and which updates and revisions  
5 are hereby approved. A summary of the specific changes to the 2021  
6 CEMP are outlined in the Executive Summary attached hereto as **Exhibit**  
7 **1** and incorporated herein by this reference. The City's CEMP was  
8 originally adopted by Resolution 2004-277-A, and amended in  
9 Resolutions 2005-710-A, 2006-1018-A, 2009-904-A, 2010-907-A, 2012-  
10 465-A, and 2017-709-A.

11 **Section 2. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue  
12 Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall oversee the  
13 project described herein.

14 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become  
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
16 without the Mayor's signature.
