Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for JSO officers to conduct security and traffic control services in the commercial corridor of Park Street and King Street in Riverside. The funds will pay the costs for up to two (2) police officers to provide these services on Fridays and Saturdays, from 11:00 p.m. until 3:00 a.m. (or for a shorter period of time within those hours depending on need and availability of officers). The security and traffic control services will be provided only when JSO officers are available until the funds are exhausted.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-2025.

Section 4. Oversight Department. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office shall oversee the project described herein.

Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the City would like to provide funding to initiate security and traffic control services in this area as soon as possible to address immediate and ongoing safety concerns.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
