5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM THE
6 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION CAPACITY
7 BUILDING GRANTS CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE
8 JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR THE PROVISION
9 OF SECURITY AND TRAFFIC CONTROL SERVICES IN THE
10 COMMERCIAL CORRIDOR OF PARK STREET AND KING
11 STREET IN RIVERSIDE AS DESCRIBED HEREIN;
12 PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2024-
13 2025; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE
14 JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; REQUESTING
15 EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING
16 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
22 listed in subsection (b):

30 The funding above is an appropriation of \$10,000 from the
31 Community Development Corporation Capacity Building Grants

1 Contingency account to the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
2 ("JSO") for the provision of security and traffic control
3 services for the commercial corridor of Park Street and
4 King Street in Riverside.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
6 Section 1 is to provide funding for JSO officers to conduct security
7 and traffic control services in the commercial corridor of Park Street
8 and King Street in Riverside. The funds will pay the costs for up to
9 two (2) police officers to provide these services on Fridays and
10 Saturdays, from 11:00 p.m. until 3:00 a.m. (or for a shorter period
11 of time within those hours depending on need and availability of
12 officers). The security and traffic control services will be provided
13 only when JSO officers are available until the funds are exhausted.

14 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated herein shall
15 not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-2025.

16 **Section 4. Oversight Department.** The Jacksonville
17 Sheriff's Office shall oversee the project described herein.

18 **Section 5. Requesting Emergency Passage Upon Introduction**
19 **Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** Emergency passage upon
20 introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the
21 emergency is that the City would like to provide funding to initiate
22 security and traffic control services in this area as soon as possible
23 to address immediate and ongoing safety concerns.

24 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
25 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
26 without the Mayor's signature.
