5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM THE SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE 6 7 SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG 8 ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO JACKSONVILLE 9 PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND, INC. ("JPEF") FOR THE SMITH EDUCATOR 10 FRANKLIN L. LEADERSHIP INITIATIVES PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") AS DESCRIBED 11 HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 12 2025-2026; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS 13 RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE 14 TO 15 EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), 16 ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT 17 WITH JPEF; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, 18 OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY 19 20 TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A 21 GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE 22 AND JACKSONVILLE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND, INC. FOR 23 THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE 24 GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE 25 FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,
within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

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8 The funding above is an appropriation of \$10,000 from the 9 Special Council Contingency account to the Subsidies and 10 Contributions to Private Org account to provide a grant to 11 Jacksonville Public Education Fund, Inc. ("JPEF") for the 12 Franklin L. Smith Educator Leadership Initiatives Program 13 (the "Program") as described herein.

14 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 15 Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to JPEF 16 for the Program as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and 17 incorporated herein by this reference. The Program was created to 18 strengthen public education by equipping teachers and school 19 administrative leaders with the skills, coaching, and support needed 20 to thrive in their positions. The Program is comprised of three 21 primary initiatives that include: (1) The Teacher Leadership 22 Initiative, (2) The Delores Barr Weaver Peer Coaching Program, and 23 The School Leadership Initiative. The Teacher Leadership (3) 24 Initiative provides monthly workshops, day-to-day coaching, and 25 research opportunities for teachers to help improve student-teacher 26 relationships, reading proficiency, attendance, and student behavior. 27 The Delores Barr Weaver Peer Coaching Program pairs experienced 28 teachers with early-career educators to provide personalized, 29 year-long coaching and support. Finally, the School Leadership Initiative trains principals 30 and assistant principals in healing-centered leadership practices to foster safe and supportive 31

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1 school environments. The City funds will be used to pay a portion 2 of the salary for JPEF's Vice President who is responsible to oversee 3 JPEF programming, including the Franklin L. Smith Educator Leadership 4 Initiatives Program.

5 Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall 6 not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

7 Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. The 8 provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through 9 a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), 10 Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with Jacksonville Public Education Fund, Inc. 11 12 This waiver is justified because JPEF is uniquely situated to provide 13 training for Duval County educators and school leaders.

14 Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is 15 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of 16 17 the City a grant agreement with Jacksonville Public Education Fund, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$10,000, subject to the Term Sheet 18 19 and Budget more particularly described in Exhibit 2, for a term 20 commencing on July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, and all other 21 contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and 22 amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action 23 necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to 24 appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for 25 26 appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code. 27

28 Section 6. Oversight Department. The Grants and 29 Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee 30 the project described herein.

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Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become

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effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
 without the Mayor's signature.
